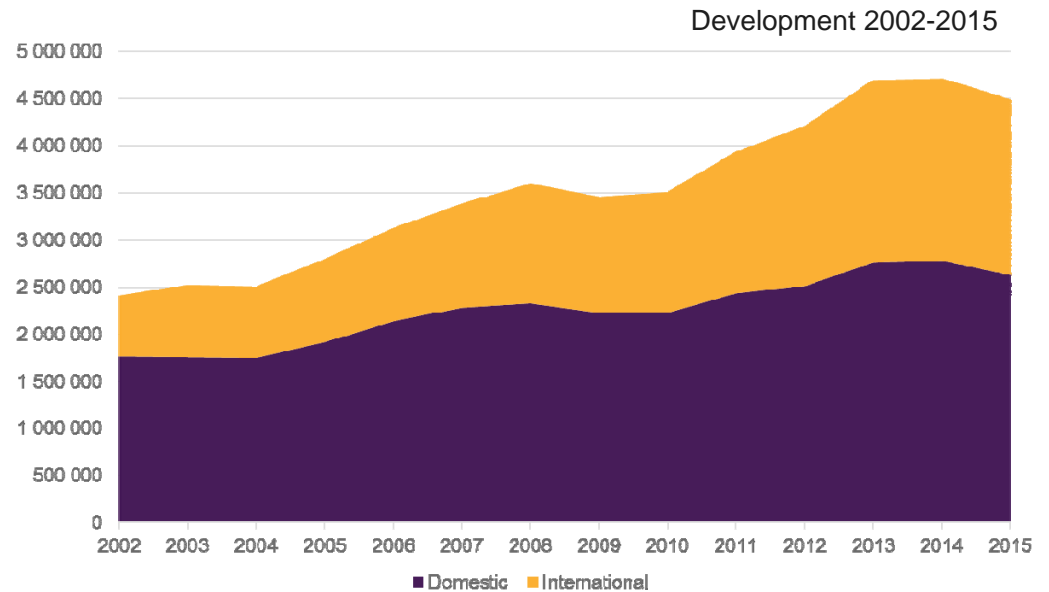
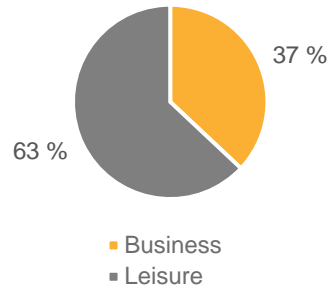
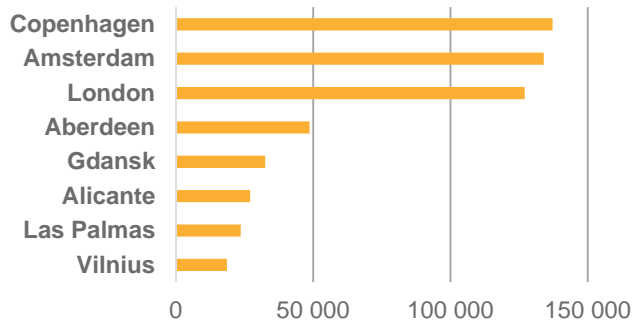


# STAVANGER AIRPORT SOLA

# POINTS TO PONDER

- Stavanger is situated in the south-west of Norway, and is the 4<sup>th</sup> largest city
- Population of approx 300,000 within 1 hour drive and approx **575,000** within 3 hours drive
- Significant business community, with energy sector as the main driver (Statoil, Shell, BP, Conocophillips, Seadrill, Total, Exxon, Eni etc.)
- Incoming leisure increasingly important
- Over 820,000 commercial room nights sold in the Stavanger region and over 300,000 cruise tourists (jan-jun 2016)

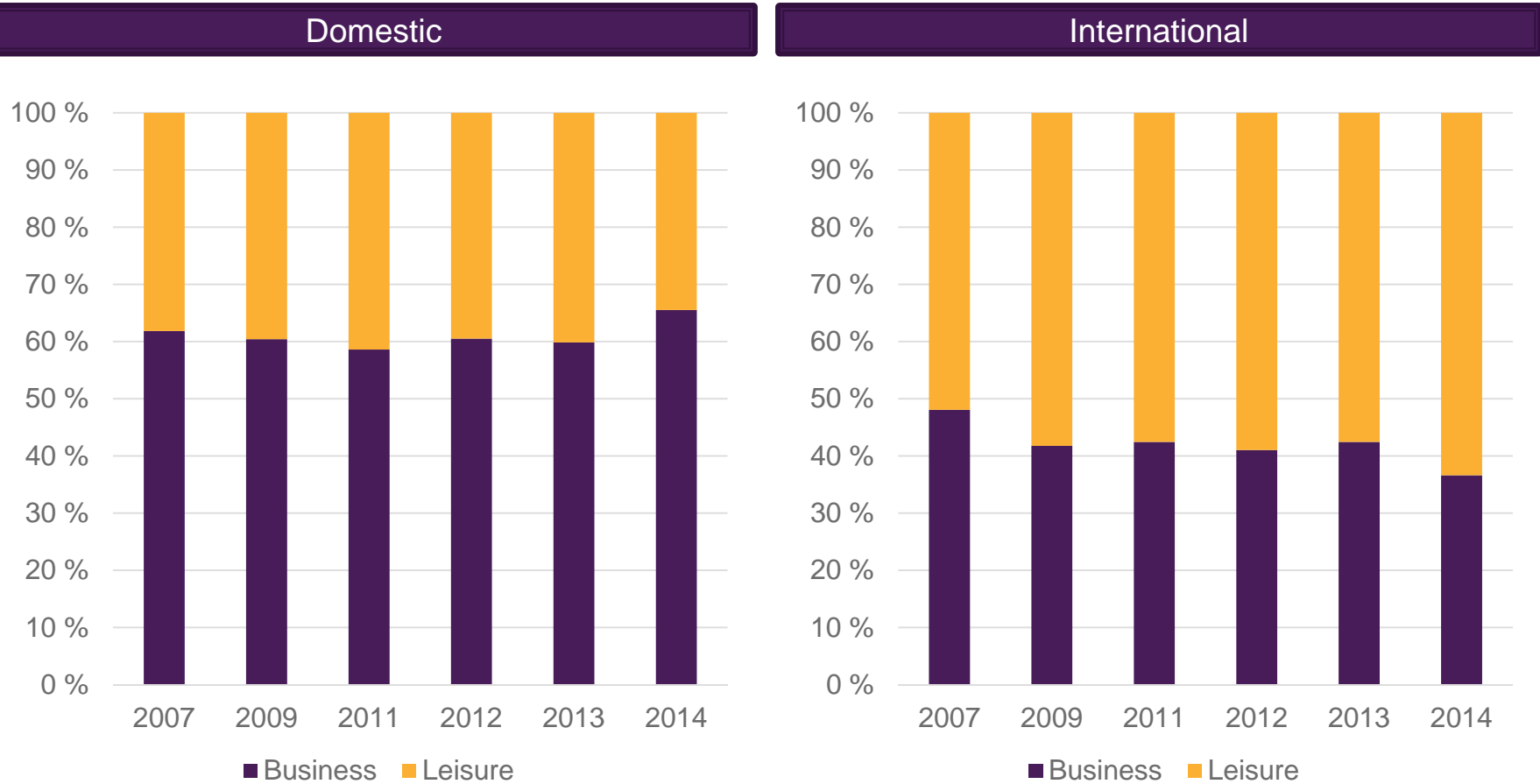
